Teach Arizona is a one-year master's degree program for people who have earned a bachelor's degree and wish to become middle or high school teachers (grades 6-12). The program begins each summer, and you can participate from anywhere in the state. Students have a full year of student teaching experience in their local school as they complete coursework.

- ❖ Bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year institution
- Strong background (approximately 18 units) in one of the approved content areas.
- ❖ 3.0 cumulative undergraduate GPA (last 60 units)

- **Tucson**: Courses offered face-to-face, with student teaching occurring in Pima County school districts.
- **Statewide**: Courses completed online and live virtual class sessions, with student teaching occurring in your local school district. F

### Can I Afford It?

- ❖ Teach AZ students are eligible to apply for the **Arizona Teachers Academy** which covers <u>ALL</u> tuition and mandatory fees if graduates agree to teach in Arizona for <u>ONE</u> year after they graduate. - Non-residents pay the same rate as residents.
